





Sigiriya Rock Fortress:



Also known as the "Lion Rock," this 5th-century fortress rises 200 meters above the surrounding jungle. The climb takes about 1-2 hours, with ancient frescoes, the Mirror Wall, and the massive lion's paws at the entrance to the summit. The top offers panoramic views and remnants of the royal palace.


Pidurangala Rock:

Located near Sigiriya, this rock offers a more rugged climb than Sigiriya but rewards with breathtaking views of Sigiriya Rock itself. A 30-40 minute hike takes you through ancient ruins and a Buddha statue.



The Dambulla Cave Temple

The Dambulla Cave Temple, also known as the Golden Temple of Dambulla, is one of the most significant Buddhist pilgrimage sites in Sri Lanka. It is a **UNESCO** World Heritage Site and is the largest and best-preserved cave temple complex in the country. Dambulla Cave Temple is an extraordinary example of Sri Lanka's Buddhist heritage, artistic traditions, and architectural mastery. Its magnificent paintings and sculptures make it an essential stop for anyone exploring Sri Lanka's cultural treasures.



Sigiriya Village Tour:



Experience traditional village life. The tour often includes a bullock cart ride, canoeing on a lake, and walking through paddy fields. Visitors can also participate in a home-cooked meal and learn about local agriculture.

Spice & Herbal Gardens in Sri Lanka

Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic:

This sacred temple houses a tooth of the Buddha, one of Sri Lanka's most important Buddhist relics. It's a beautifully ornate complex with rituals and ceremonies that occur daily, including offerings and drumming.



Kandy Cultural Dance Show:

Held in the evening, this show presents traditional Kandyan dance and drumming. Performers showcase dances that represent Sri Lanka's rich history and heritage, often ending with fire-walking.



Peradeniya Botanical Gardens:



These gardens are home to over 4,000 plant species, including a stunning orchid house, giant bamboo, and towering palm trees. It's a perfect spot for nature lovers and offers peaceful walking paths.

Tea Factory Visit:

Nuwara Eliya is known for its high-quality Ceylon tea. At the tea factory, you'll learn about the tea-making process, from picking leaves to fermentation and drying. You can also taste and purchase freshly made tea.



Horton Plains National Park



Horton Plains is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Sri Lanka's most scenic national parks, located at an altitude of 2,100–2,300 meters in the Central Highlands. It is famous for its misty landscapes, rolling grasslands, cloud forests, and diverse wildlife. Ideal for hiking and nature lovers, Horton Plains offers a 9.5 km circular trail with stunning views and a cool climate.

Gregory Lake:

Located in the heart of Nuwara Eliya, Gregory Lake offers boating, pony rides, and cycling along the shore. The cool climate and serene environment make it an ideal place for relaxation.



Scenic Train Journey from Nanu Oya to Ella



The train journey from Nanu Oya to Ella is considered one of the most beautiful train rides in the world, offering breathtaking views of Sri Lanka's hill country. It is part of the famous Kandy to Ella railway line, built during the British colonial period. This train journey is a must-do for nature lovers and travelers seeking a peaceful yet adventurous experience in Sri Lanka's highlands.

Victoria Park:

This well-maintained park is perfect for a leisurely stroll or birdwatching. It's especially beautiful during the flowering seasons, with vibrant blooms adding color to the tranquil atmosphere.



Strawberry Farms:

Due to its cool climate, Nuwara Eliya has many strawberry farms where visitors can pick strawberries or enjoy freshly made strawberry desserts like jams and milkshakes.



Galle Fort – A Timeless Colonial Gem



Galle Fort, also known as the Dutch Fort, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the best-preserved colonial fortresses in Asia. Located in southern Sri Lanka, it was originally built by the Portuguese in 1588 and later fortified by the Dutch in 1649. A walk through Galle Fort feels like stepping back in time, offering a mix of history, culture, and charm with a tropical seaside setting.

Kosgoda Turtle Hatchery:



This conservation project protects endangered sea turtles. You can observe the rehabilitation of injured turtles, see hatchlings, and learn about the turtle conservation process. Visitors may even get the chance to release baby turtles into the ocean.

Day 4

- Visit Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic at 9:00

- Visit Peradeniya botanical garden
- Visit tea plantations and tea factory
- Overnight stay at **Nuwaraeliya**

- Visit Yala safari (evening or next day morning safari)
- Overnight stay at **Yala**

Day 8


- Proceed to Galle
